- In addition to the complaint process at Audrain Developmental Disability Services, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Attention: Title VI Program Coordinator; East Building, 5th Floor TCT; 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE; Washington, DC 20590.
- 3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
- 4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
